Sondra has been active in music since early childhood. She began playing for services at her home church in Dunkirk, IN, when she was 9 years old. She became the organist there when she was 13 and continued until she graduated from High school.

After college she became organist at Auburn First United Methodist church and served there for 29 years as organist, accompanist, and head of the music department. At that time, she also earned a Piano Performance/Accompanying degree, Magna Cum Laude from Indiana University.

She also performed with the Auburn Community Theater representing the U.S. in the Royal Exchange Amateur Theatre Festival in Manchester, England, as well as playing for the Hoosier Choral during six trips to countries in Europe, and 12 yeas as the accompanist for the Fort Wayne Children's Choir traveling the U.S., Canada and England.

In 1999, Sondra and her husband, Richard moved to Tucson, AZ when she was hired as the organist/Chancel Choir accompanist for St. Mar United Methodist Church. She as served there as director of music and is now the director of the Celebration Singers. She has also accompanied at the University of Arizona and has a piano/organ/voice studio that has presented a recital every year.
